

Application for Painting, Cleaning and Maintenance of Hull above the Load Line

I, the above signed, hereby apply to undertake hull painting / cleaning / maintenance on the vessel above. I agree to ensure that the following requirements are met:

1. Use of ladders, scaffolding and cherry pickers must comply with relevant OHS requirements.
2. Rust and paint particles removed from the hull must be contained and collected on the barge and wharf area.
3. Tarpaulins or similar should be secured from ship to barge/wharf to enable collection of all rust and paint particulates removed and paint drips during application. Tie up point should be at close intervals to ensure gaps between ship and barge/wharf are closed.
4. Only approved anti-fouling paints in accordance with the International Maritime Organisation Convention should be used.
5. Adequate collection bins must be available on barge/wharf for placing material removed from the hull.
6. All waste collected should be deemed as quarantine waste and disposed via a qualified Contractor and in accordance with EPA Victoria regulations. Approved Contractors are listed in the Port Handbook.
7. In the event of a spill Harbour Control must be informed and adequate action taken to contain the spill as per PoMC Emergency Management Plan.
8. Work should not proceed on a windy day when containment of particulates would not be possible with the operational controls in place and when activities carried out would be unsafe.
9. **Contact Harbour Control on VHF 12 or telephone 9644 9700 prior to commencing and ending of approved works. Additional requirements may be placed on the vessel by Harbour Control.**
