Removal of old mooring piles, Footscray Wharf

To improve local river safety, Port of Melbourne Corporation (PoMC) will shortly remove old mooring piles from the Maribyrnong River adjacent to Footscray Wharf, Footscray.

The works will involve the use of heavy construction machinery, including a pile removal barge, in the Maribyrnong River in the vicinity of Footscray Wharf. Works are being undertaken in accordance with approvals obtained from Parks Victoria.

Timing

Works are expected to commence on **Tuesday 30 June 2009** and continue for approximately four days between the hours of 7am and 6pm, weather permitting.

Expected impacts

During the works, access to waters adjacent to Footscray Wharf and vessels moored in this area may be temporarily restricted for short periods of time. Noise may be experienced. PoMC will attempt to minimise impacts, where practical.

We appreciate your patience during this activity, which will assist to improve safety in the Maribyrnong River.
